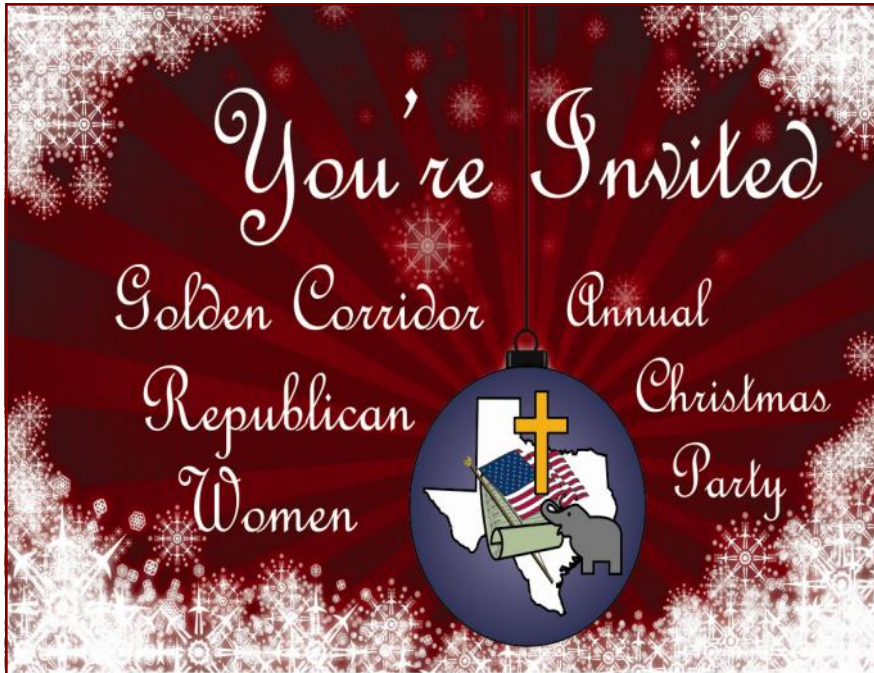

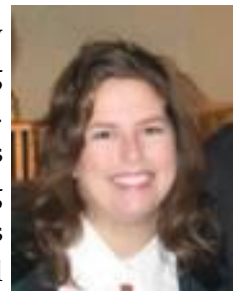
President's Pen

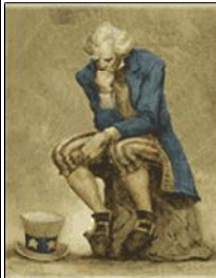

New Nebraska Law Sets Standard

The new Nebraska law — the Pain-capable Unborn Child Protection Act — took effect Oct. 15 and establishes a new standard in abortion bans. Rather than setting the benchmark at fetal viability, which can be 22 to 24 weeks, Nebraska’s law utilizes evidence that an unborn child experiences pain at 20 weeks for its guideline. LeRoy Carhart plans to take his late-term abortion business to other states after a new Nebraska law banning the procedure at 20 weeks of pregnancy took effect. Carhart of Bellevue, Neb., told the Omaha World-Herald he plans to begin providing late-term abortions at new clinics in the Washington, D.C. area and Council Bluffs, Iowa. He also said he plans to expand an abortion facility in Indianapolis, Ind. Carhart is possibly the best known, late-term abortion doctor in the United States. Carhart told The Washington Post, “The laws are more favorable in these other jurisdictions, and we’re going to do the maximum the law allows.”

Military Abortions, Homosexuality Vote Coming Soon

There is a critical vote coming up quickly regarding abortion in the U.S.

Senate, probably very soon after Thanksgiving. The lame duck Senate will vote on the National Defense Authorization Bill and, as we explained in the Sept. 17, 2010 e-Notes, Majority Leader Harry Reid is trying an end run to give some "thank you gifts" to his left-wing base. How? By adding some very controversial amendments to this Defense bill:

Repeal of the "Don't Ask, Don't Tell" military policy, which will impose open homosexuality upon the U.S. armed services, without waiting for the pending military report which is analyzing the effect of such a policy;

Allowing abortions to be performed on any military base in the world, utilizing personnel, supplies and facilities paid for with our tax dollars, which, under current law, has been prohibited since 1966. Another provision in the law which would be changed prohibits the use of DOD funds for abortion except to save the life of the mother.


Sen. John McCain led a successful filibuster against the bill last September and is planning to do so again. He needs 41 votes in order to sustain his objection to the bill coming to the floor for a full Senate vote (the technical term for a filibuster). This again is possible if all the GOP Senators stick together and refuse to invoke cloture (a procedure to cut off de-

bate and bring the bill to the floor for a vote) as Reid will request.

An avid supporter of the military, Sen. McCain knows that the needed military funding can easily be provided with a continuing resolution minus these left-wing amendments. If the amendments are voted on individually, we would have to rally 51 votes to defeat each one, and we don't have those votes. Thus, sustaining the filibuster (only 41 votes needed) is our only chance to stop them in the Senate!

Stem Cell Arguments Set Dec. 6 in D.C.

Oral arguments in a lawsuit against the Obama administration’s policy supporting federal funding of stem cell research that destroys human embryos is set for Dec. 6 before a three-judge panel of the U.S. District Court of Appeals for the District of Columbia. President Obama issued an executive order in March 2009 that overturned a prohibition instituted by President Bush on federal funding of stem cell research that results in the destruction of embryos. Richard Land, president of the Ethics & Religious Liberty Commission, urged “all Americans who value the sanctity of human life to lift up the Court of Appeals judges in prayer and to importune the Lord to intervene on behalf of the unborn.”
